To clear outbreak status we need to have 14 days without a new COVID case. Our most recent positive case was reported on September 10, 2024.

Bayview staff will continue to wear masks throughout the building at this time.

All visitors are now required to wear a mask in public spaces.

While we are not <u>yet</u> mandating masks for our independent residents, we strongly urge you to consider wearing a mask in public spaces knowing that we have residents at a higher risk for infection. Together we can stop the spread.

A few reminders:

- If you are not feeling well, please take care of yourself, consult your primary care physician if applicable, and stay home to avoid getting anyone else sick.
- We encourage the use of rapid self-tests, also called at-home tests, as a quick and convenient way to screen for COVID-19 on your own. You may find rapid tests in stores, pharmacies and online.
